RJN Group, Inc. Selected for Evaluation and Rehabilitation for the Trinity River Authority of Texas

Wheaton, IL (January 7, 2008) – RJN Group, Inc. was selected to evaluate the existing EF-3 Interceptor for the Trinity River Authority of Texas (TRA). The existing EF-3 Interceptor includes 42 and 45-inch diameter RCP pipe that is experiencing capacity issues as noted in a Wastewater Collection System Masterplan prepared by the TRA. RJN's responsibilities include determining the condition of the pipe using CCTV inspection to decide if the pipe can be used in conjunction with a parallel relief line. An existing parallel line was removed from service many years ago and RJN is also evaluating reuse of that line. RJN will study the existing conditions and make recommendations in a Preliminary Engineering Report to the TRA before preparing final design plans for the project. The final design will be based on available technology and RJN will recommend the most cost effective method in order to achieve the required capacity. The assessment began in September 2008 and is scheduled for completion in September 2009.
